
Desert District Scoutmobile Race

1. The Desert District Scoutmobile Race will be held on 13 December 2003 at 2:00 PM at the corner of Cielo and Norma Streets, south Ridgecrest. This is the **NOT** location that was used last year. However, this new location provides a course on a dead-end street which will be an improvement over previous years. The hill will be open at 1:15 PM for practice. Directions to the race location are listed below.

2. Safety equipment must be used. Bicycle helmets are allowable so please bring helmets, bicycle or motorcycle. Gloves are required and are a valuable item of safety equipment. Brakes do not have to be used. If the brake design is not safe, Scouts are far better off using their shoes rather than a brake that is ineffective and may be a hazard.

3. A design drawing for building a Scoutmobile is available upon request. Also available is a parts list and instructions for building a Scoutmobile. This design does not have to be used. Please add a "push bar" to the design if you wish. If you wish to use wheels from roller skates, skateboards, etc., please do so. At the price charged for the suggested wheels, anything that rolls and is safe is fine.

4. Prizes will be awarded for the First, Second and Third places in the racing categories. Please note that there will be no official judging for the best decorated. There will be donated holiday gift certificates presented as awards to the Cub Scout and Boy Scout First, Second and Third place finishers. The object is for Scouts to have a good time safely. Please join us on Saturday, 13 December, 2003.
